The price of holidays can fluctuate a great deal throughout the year, so you can save a lot if you are flexible with your travel dates and avoid peak holiday times. It can be also cheaper if you book well in advance. Before your departure, make sure you get as much information about your destination as you can. Will you be able to access your own money easily enough or will you need to take cash with you? If your flight is **delayed**, or your luggage is lost, these can be difficult to obtain in an airport or foreign country.
